From the 413 Bypass or Newtown, take Route 332 West/Newtown-Richboro Road towards Richboro to the traffic light at the intersection of Holland Road (Landmark – Fleuhr Funeral Home on the left). Turn left onto Holland Road and proceed 2.5 miles to Churchville Lane (shortly after the railroad tracks). Turn right onto Churchville Lane and go approximately 1/8 mile to the Nature Center on the right.
